Friends of the African Union (FAU) new 2017 position on Israel:

The chimera engendered by the Oslo Agreement should have been dispelled early on.

In 2012, the year we were established, the FAU's founders knew that eight months after signing that agreement, Yasser Arafat declared that the jihad to liberate Jerusalem would continue. He compared Oslo to the [Hudaybiya] agreement reached by Prophet Mohammed and the Quraysh tribe, which was abrogated at an opportune time and saw all the tribe members slaughtered.

We believe that for at least 3 generations the leadership of the Palestinians have made ambiguous statements and lied to the "West", claiming in English "that they want peace" and yet in Arabic to their own people pledging for Israel's destruction.

They systematically incited hatred towards Israel, which in many cases resulted in deadly terror and even deadlier responses thereby increasing the circle of violence and intolerance.

Since there is nothing grey on their intentions in the destruction of the state of Israel, and with that understanding the FAU is renewing its support for Israel in the context of this proclamation and currently in pursuit to gain the full support of all African nations and the African Diaspora.

For many years, Israel has demonstrated support for Africa and the people of African Descent who are of the Jewish religion, they have assisted in technological inventions to poor people in several African countries and continue to seek commerce ties with Africa on many levels, including aid for victims of famine.

Thereby we state:

1. There should be peace between Israel and all its neighbors, but without compromising the security of the Jewish state.

2. Israel has the right to exist as a Jewish nation.
3. We support a plebiscite among the Palestinians to choose whether to accept Israel in peace or not. If to accept we will work with all nations and African civil society for that two-state solution.
4. At the same time if they reject peace and separate statehood as they have done in the past we will support actions that will undermine their ability to cause war and disinvestment actions on Israel, the Jewish People and their allies.
5. We support those decedents of the Jewish religion, who can prove residency of their families in the past before 1948, whose ancestors came out of the nations of the African Union and or live there today. They are considered People of African Descent for membership in the Friends of the African Union. They can join the FAU Chapter of the country they reside in now. All FAU College Chapters are open to all People of African Descent. Our first College Chapter will be in Cincinnati Ohio. The goal is 300 college chapters by September 2018.
6. Those who can prove residency of their families in the past before 1948 in the nations of the African Union and whose ancestors came out of the nations of the African Union or live there today and or born of African slavery and who are now in either case are citizens of the state of Israel can join the FAU Israel Bureau. The FAU Israel Bureau is to be launched July 10th 2017 in Cincinnati Ohio via teleconference and Google hangout.
7. We will create a task force to implement a public private partnership with members of the Jewish religion and their allies through FAU Israel and other allied FAU Bureaus and Chapters for capitalization of solutions to the problems of the People of the African Diaspora (PAD) and the African Union including those people who live in Israel.

undivided support to Israel, and through a unity effort between Israel and the Friends of the African Union, as well as other allies including people in the African Union in the USA and elsewhere.

The FAU will employ it as a new momentum efforts to achieve a real peace in the region which will cost approximately \$100B a year for the next 100 years, will use the same formula we are using in Africa in the Daniels IDIQ2 Program for Africa.

This new unified effort between FAU and Israel will set the stage for commerce partnership that will add support to stimulate the domestic American economy via the "White House Office of American Innovation using a Quantitative Easing based debt purchasing public private partnership (P3) program developed by Hershel Daniels Junior, the Chairman of the Friends of the African Union named – "The Daniels IDIQ2".

Below is how such a program could work using the framework established in FAU's signature to the 5 year \$30B Fifth Third Bank Community Benefit Agreement.

We will demonstrate the 100-year program commitment by the \$3T Commitment to African American that is supportive of creating billion-dollar trade with Africa in 300 congressional districts including that of the Congressional Black Caucus. This will show that we can create a \$10T program in support of the two states solution from unilateral actions of President Trump and his administration along with congressional allies.

In this demonstration by Friends of the African Union and our Jewish allies we would propose executive action by the President of a \$3T USD Quantitative Easing based debt purchasing program (The Daniels IDIQ2) as a solution for the fundamental injustice, cruelty, brutality, and inhumanity of African slavery in the United States of America between 1787 and 1865 and its progenitors the 13 American colonies between 1619 and 1787 along with its effects subsequently de jure and de facto of racial and economic discrimination on the descendant Americans of America's African slavery, It addresses the damage incurred by past and current federal government racism against freed African Slaves in the United States from 1865 to 1867 and African Americans from 1867 to 2014 that settles any propoganda that the slave trade was created, controlled, and carried out by Jewish peoples. It will be a stimulus to the American Economy that

interagency response set forth by the US State Department to the United Nations Universal Periodic Review of the United States of America in 2015 that said Civil Rights, Ethnic, and Racial Discrimination is the number one human rights problem in the United States of America;

(3) draws on already established Executive authority and market infrastructure;

(4) helps the other Americans through indirect associations by creation of supportive ancillary jobs and entrepreneurial opportunities thereby supporting the advancement of the American people as a whole, and;

(5) is just adequate enough to implement real changes that reverse long-standing conditions caused by systemic de jure and de facto racial and economic discrimination, as documented in depth elsewhere and provides a means from 2017 to 2117 address these issues with a 100 year capital trust to do so.

The Goodwill of this program in terms of support for Israel would be based on FAU expansion in these five centers from the first funds received as a startup:

- In the USA we would create 300 FAU Chapters by the new FAU African Week at the Congressional Black Caucus Annual Legislative Conference that have allied Chapters located in colleges that are supportive of our position on Israel. We will tell that story at the 47th Annual Legislative Conference that will take place September 20 to 24, 2017 at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center in Washington D.C with our Chapters from their Congressional Districts and or states ie California and New Jersey;
- Each chapter we will create an interfaith alliance with conservative Christians who are supportive of Israel with a focus on African American Christians and African nationals who are Christians. The first of these will be in Cincinnati and we will be operating in 20 states by June 19th 2017 if we are funded by May 25th 2017, which is African Liberation Day, as we will have a media campaign underway;
- our plan to is to implement using the African Dollar - a new Cyber currency of FAU & Allies with Israel and its allies;

- In the United Nations through the Universal Periodic Review of the USA which also addresses national security as a human right and the lies of the leadership of the Palestinian people put America at risk, and;
- in the African Union (AU) itself as an AU authorized sixth region civil society organization with over 500 FAU chapters worldwide by June 19th 2018.

Background:

FAU, through its Friends of the African Union Chamber of Commerce, a long term National Community Reinvestment Coalition (NCRC) member, has gained additional financial experience and expertise in Community Benefit Agreements (CBA) as one of 136 signers to the historic NCRC 5th Third Bank \$30B 5-year (2016-2020) CBA.

FAU will use those CBA agreements to shape the above private sector funding mechanism with 100 global partners in this manner:

These partners (from a current prequalified market of 320 including many companies owned by Israelis and or Jewish people) would have a written agreement in the P3 using the Daniels IDIQ2 whereas over the next 100 years they will invest \$300M a year or \$30B a company through 2117. Together their cumulative yearly total is \$30B a year from 2017 to 2117. These can be 100 investment pools with the aforementioned 100 companies at the core. Or we can expand it to 1,000 and reduce yearly to \$30M.

That is a pledges \$3T investment will create a program to Make Africa Great through a partnership between African Americans, the African Union and the world Jewish Community under another P3 between Friends of the African Union and partners, President Trump and the Congressional Black Caucus that our banking group will create with a capitalization of \$300B using the African dollar in 300 markets around the USA in which all transactions will be carried out using this cyber currency financial infrastructure that would invest in domestic housing, commercial buildings, Small Business Administration Business Loans and government Infrastructure Bonds.

Our preference for this P3 CEO is to hire Rosalind Brewer, the ex CEO of the \$57B Sam's Club.

"In initial steps FAU would look to create with Israel a new financial technology company" founded between African Americans and Israelis to finance African Americans and Africa. This company would be capitalized by leveraging that capitalization with a FAU request to one of three banks that have Community Benefit Agreements with NCRC - KeyBank (who operates in NY), Fifth Third Bank and or Huntington Bancshares, after an investment by Jewish interests that would then own property in NYC and Cincinnati.

\$1M Capitalization this month before April 29th 2017.

Note 1: As a example the P3 can prove for the people of the future Palestinian state that we could raise \$10T. This would then provide the \$100B a year for the peace process of two states or the \$150B a year in funds for the state of Israel if they reject peace.

Note 2: Use of proceeds of \$3TbDaniels IDIQ based on a 5 year Revenue Anticipation Note that would buy the following debt ...

\$2T US Housing Market
\$500B LMI market
\$500B public housing
\$500B NMTC based projects
\$500B Market Rate

\$700B workforce program for the 3.75m unemployed African Americans via expansion of employers who will hire the aforementioned African americans including USPS and Amtrak LBO that support food AID to Africa

\$300B business development funding including international trade with Africa based on creation 300 FAU Community reinvestment coalition's like being done in Cincinnati with the Queen City Community Reinvestment Coalition Company. Ref.:
